 - ~ Recognition that the MDoT-LAPP approach requires additional documents.
 - ~ An explanation of the 75% Design Components.
 - ~ An explanation of the 75% Design Cost Budget
 - A detailed breakdown of the roles and responsibilities for each of the project participants including associated fees.
- 5. Regina proposed that Dean should be the person presenting this proposal to the BoS.
- 6. Dylan noted that he has been working with Denis to draft the Zoning & Design Standards Scope of Services document.
- 7. Ron reminded the group about the joint meeting with the Planning Board scheduled for June 25th.
- 8. Our next regular meeting will be at 8:30am on Thursday, July16th at the Museums of Old York Parsons Center.
